INLEIDING

INSTITUTIONAL HISTORY

Aims and founding

The International Humanist and Ethical Union (IHEU) is the sole global umbrella organisation embracing humanist, atheist, rationalist, secularist, skeptic, *laique*, ethical cultural, freethought and similar organisations worldwide. The IHEU supports its Member Organizations and works to foster the growth and development of the Humanist network around the world.

The (IHEU) was founded in Amsterdam (the Netherlands) on August 26 1952, by seven humanist organizations from Western Europe, the USA, and India. The aims of the new organization were 'to establish permanent relations between humanist and ethical groups all over the world', as well as to serve as a vehicle 'to shape humanism and ethical culture as a positive and constructive philosophy of life', as Jaap van Praag put it in his opening speech to the founding congress.¹ Van Praag's latter remark referred to the fact that the decision to found the Union was taken after it had appeared that an already existing federation, the World Union of Freethinkers, was vehemently and, in the view of the IHEU founders, negatively anti-religious.

From 1952 until 1996 the IHEU Office was located in the premises of one of its founding organizations in the Netherlands, Humanistisch Verbond (HV; Humanist Association), located at Utrecht. In January 1997 IHEU Headquarters moved to London, though until 1998 a small auxiliary branch, with one part-timer, remained in Utrecht, at the building of the Universiteit voor Humanistiek (University of Humanistic Studies).

Organisation

Board of Directors

The IHEU is an organization of Member Organizations. Most of the office work came to be performed at the headquarters of the Dutch Humanist Verbond (HV) at Utrecht, as HV was the largest of the seven founding organizations and had hosted the Amsterdam congress. In addition the IHEU chairman, Jaap van Praag, happened to be the president of HV too, and had shown impressive organizing capacities in building up the Dutch HV organization from scratch.

Initially, IHEU had two administrative layers, the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee (ec). In the Board of Directors every member organization was represented—two seats for the full members, one for members with consultative status. However, the Board did not often meet in person. It met only at congresses, once in every five years.

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee was a smaller body and could meet more frequently. It consisted of seven persons: the Chairman, the Secretary and the Treasurer, two representatives from IHEU's full member organizations (mo's), and two Dutch supporting staff acting as (Honorary) Organizational Secretary and (Honorary) Organizational Treasurer —'honorary' meaning that they were volunteers. The Executive Committee convened every summer. The decisions it proposed to take were communicated by post mail to all the Board Members. Unless they protested within two months, the decisions became final.

Chairmans committee/ Organizing committee

As work multiplied rapidly already in February 1955 a paid part-time 'assistant (organizing) secretary' was hired. She worked at the office of Dutch HV. This introduced a third layer of administration which called for its own staff meetings, the Chairman's Committee (later called Organizing Committee). Its two-monthly meetings are mentioned for the first time in 1959, but the Committee probably existed earlier. It consisted not only of the four Dutch IHEU staff (Chairman, Organizing Secretary, Organizing Treasurer, and Assistant Secretary), but also, apparently for practical reasons, of two staff of HV: its office manager and an 'assessor'.

$Staff\ and\ representatives$

A number of persons are working for IHEU in various capacities. This includes office staff, international representatives and the representatives at international bodies. A long time staffmember was Ernst van Brakel (*October 12th 1937). He was a staff member form 1965 tot 1998. He served among others as Executive Director. He was also IHEU's representative at UNESCO from 1967 to 1980. J. W. F. Klein-von Baumhauer, (July 3rd 1927 - June 29th 2008) became in 1966 honorary (volunteer) organizing secretary and was general secretary from 1982 to 1996. In the 1990s she wrote "Nettie's Column" in International Humanist News, the magazine of IHEU. In 1996, at the World Congress, she received the International Humanist Award, a prize of IHEU. R .A.P. Tielman (August 1946) became involved in 1972, when he joined the organizing committee of volunteers, with special responsibility for dialogues. In 1975 he became Board Member. From 1986 to 1996 he was Co-Chairman and from 1996 to 1998 President.

Network of contacts

IHEU also has a network of contact persons in countries where there is no Humanist organization yet, or where the local organization is newly formed or very small.

Activities

The 1962 Oslo Congress in some respects marks the coming of age of IHEU. The preceding decade can be characterized as a period of preparation: IHEU's purposes and philosophy had been defined, headquarters had concentrated on exchanging information between member organizations so as to help them in getting to know each other better, a working organization had been built up.

At the Oslo Congress enthusiastic and ambitious plans for the future were launched: IHEU should be a kind of command center to stimulate humanism and humanist organizations worldwide. Another sign of IHEU's maturity is that it concentrated increasingly on practical activities instead of theoretical self-definition. Specific projects were set up, such as the Bihar Third World development project and various dialogues; working parties were created to discuss specific areas of practical activity; the frequency of the congresses was increased. A trend from theory to practice is also visible from the central themes that were chosen for the congresses.

1968 was a turning-point for IHEU. Before 1968 IHEU's membership and budget grew, after 1968 both stabilized. Before 1968 many new activities were started, after 1968 few activities were entirely new. The main exception was the International Humanist Award, which was presented for the first time in 1970.

The organization works on activities that are global or international in scope, for example on issues that affect many countries, or in forums that are international in focus. Through IHEU, humanists have a place at the table in international affairs. The IHEU is able to speak from a specifically humanist perspective, representing its members and supporters at international bodies like the United Nations in Geneva and New York, the African Commission on Human and Peoples Rights, the Council of Europe, and others. This means the organisation is able to influence international law and the human rights framework. This is the IHEU core area of the policy work.

Working Parties

At congresses humanists from all over the world met in person. This presented an opportunity to organize collateral personal meetings, such as Board meetings, national and specialized conferences, and Working Parties. The latter were permanent committees, generally consisting of between five and thirty members from the various full member organizations, that discussed specific areas of IHEU or humanist activity. The groups exchanged information, experiences and opinions in their own specific area, in order to provide the staff of member organizations with first-hand documentation regarding relevant activities by humanist organizations in

other countries. Between congresses, the working parties maintained contact by post mail. Apparently, many Working Parties had difficulties in keeping up their momentum.

International representation

The 1952 Amsterdam congress had in three out of its five resolutions pledged support for United Nations ideals. One of the first tasks the Executive Committee took upon itself, was therefore to become a consultative member of unesco. Theo Polet was the IHEU representative; he was succeeded by Ernst van Brakel (1967-1980).

In the 1970s IHEU began to expand its network of international representatives, which up until then had been restricted to two posts (unesco at Paris, and United Nations at New York). In 1981 the Board decided that it would be useful if IHEU were not only represented at the European Parliament, but also at the Council of Europe, where more European states are represented.

The second new IHEU post was at the United Nations in Geneva, where A. James Dilloway has been the IHEU representative from 1976 to 1997. Since 1981 the IHEU has also been represented at the United Nations in Vienna.

Around 1990 two IHEU representatives were added to the already existing five. As the powers of the European institutions increased. One year later IHEU was also given consultative status at unicef, New York. Representation in Brussels has been taken over in 1993 by the European Humanist Federation, which effectively consists of the European IHEU member organizations. In 2000 the IHEU status at the United Nations was upgraded to 'Special Consultative ngo Status', which automatically entitles IHEU to contribute statements to ecosoc, the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (New York), where IHEU until then was not represented. To be more effective, several IHEU delegations have since the early 1990s been enlarged and reformed. For instance, the team at the United Nations in New York now consists of five persons.

Dialogues

Dialogues with Protestant Christians have never been very successful. Since 1967 IHEU approached the World Council of Churches (WCC) to discuss the possibilities of constructive co-operation, and in 1968 the IHEU Chairman and Secretary personally visited Geneva for talks with the WCC. To no avail, the Council turned out to be not interested. On the other hand, an IHEU dialogue with the Marxists seemed more promising.

From the late 1960s IHEU started to conduct so many dialogues that it sometimes looks as if they called any meeting a 'dialogue'. Among others there were dialogues with South African Apartheid defenders, the Club of Rome, Buddhists and Hindus, homosexuals and freethinkers.

Concern with Human Rights

At the 1978 Board meeting Co-Chairman Tielman proposed several projects that might be useful in three ways: furthering intrinsical humanist aims, being instrumental in procuring positive publicity, and presenting good perspectives for acquiring external funding. The most illustrious proposal was to create an international humanist ombudsman with whom complaints could be lodged in cases where human rights were violated, in particular human rights of non-religious people or cases which involved the separation of church and state. The ombudsman would then start an investigation and, if appropriate, would take further measures such as legal action to support the victim. The prospective ombudsman should be an eminent and widely respected international law expert. Ivo Samkalden, a former Dutch Minister of Justice and mayor of Amsterdam, was willing to take up the function, but was not immediately available. He was appointed in 1983, on which occasion his function was renamed Commissioner for Human Rights (CHR). In 1986 Samkalden was succeeded ad interim by former Dutch judge Pieter van Dijk, in 1988 Jan Glastra van Loon, a former Dutch Secretary of State for Justice became CHR.

The Commissioner led an 'Ombudsteam' that had already started work in 1979. It consisted of volunteer legal specialists, who could in turn draw on a network of other experts both in the Netherlands and abroad, for example to get precise information on countries where violations occurred. The team was secretarially supported by a conscientious objector, who fulfilled his military service in this alternative way. The Commissioner and his team closely cooperated with other human rights organizations, such as Amnesty International, but tried to concentrate on issues that other organizations did not cover well. The first 'niche' were rights of humanists and other non-believers, or cases where the separation between church and state was at stake. For instance, the Commissioner supported a campaign to separate church and state in Ireland by offering legal advice regarding the lodging of complaints with the European Court at Strasbourg. Further, the Commissioner attended to 'sensitive' kinds of human rights violations that most international organizations shied away from. Examples are conscientious objection, homosexuality, or the right to abortion.

Publications on the history of IHEU

In 2002 a history of IHEU was published, written by Hans van Deukeren of the Humanistisch Archief (HA; in 2011 renamed to Humanistisch Historisch Centrum (Humanist Historical Centre (HHC)).² Earlier, in 1977 and 1992, short histories of IHEU

appeared in anniversary issues of the IHEU periodicals.³ In compiling these histories Ernst van Brakel, a long-time staff member at the IHEU office at Utrecht, the Netherlands, played a major role. Shortly after 1992 Van Brakel once again undertook writing a history,⁴ but this project was never finished.

HISTORY AND DESCRIBING OF THE ARCHIVES

History

As told above, the IHEU Office was located from 1952 until 1996 at the HV in Utrecht and moved in January 1997 to London. Some years earlier, in January 1993, due to financial problems HV had moved to a smaller office at Utrecht's Nieuwegracht. At this occasion IHEU office room space was severely reduced and in addition a cellar that had been used before to store IHEU archives no longer was available. In view of this lack of space IHEU decided to accept an offer from the Universiteit voor Humanistiek in Utrecht to store its archives there. They stayed there as IHEU moved tot London.

Since the early 1990s plans had been developed to found an archival institution especially dedicated to keeping archives of humanist organizations and individuals. When in October 1996 this institution was realized in the form of the Humanist Archives (HA), it took care of the IHEU archives that were lodged, like itself, at the Universiteit voor Humanistiek. In May 2000, the IHEU General Assembly (formerly the Board of Directors) sanctioned and confirmed this situation by agreeing that the HA would be the official archival keeper of IHEU archives.

Describing

Subsequent to this decision, the HA started conducting an inventory for the IHEU archives, which measured some 50 meters shelf length. The post–1990 parts were processed first, because this material was needed at IHEU Headquarters in London for administrative and public relations purposes. An inventory was published as a result of this conduction, performed jointly by Pieter Edelman, Jan Loman and Hans van Deukeren of the HA.⁵ After completion of the period 1990–1997, the same team proceeded with the period 1952–1989. The original inventory for the period 1952–1989 consisted of 305 folders and bundles; that for 1990–1997 245.

The IHEU archives were quite fragmented. A major part of it, covering the period 1952–1976, was deposited in 1981 at the Rijksarchief Utrecht (RAU; State Archives of the Province of Utrecht; now called Het Utrechts Archief (HUA; The Utrecht Archives)) as part of the Humanistisch Verbond archives.⁶ Later, documents covering the period 1976–1989 were added. However, in 1993 large parts of the archives still remained at the HV/IHEU Office. In 2011 all remaining parts were brought to the HHC (Humanist Historical Centre). The ultimate aim was to integrate all IHEU archives into a single collection. This project was concluded by the HHC in 2013, when the IHEU archives were transferred to the Het Utrechts Archief.

Irradiated documents

After completion of the 1990–1997 describing, these archives were, with the exception of documentary and audio-visual materials, sent to IHEU Headquarters in London in August 2001. In 2011 they were returned to the HHC. Because of the technical condition they were in, they first had to be irradiated by a specialist company. The documents cannot be irradiated again, for this will bring irreparable damage to the material. In this inventory this is the case for the numbers #xxxx.

Selection

The material is mostly of an unique nature. This is, besides the usual various ingoing and outgoing correspondences, in particular true for the beginning period of IHEU, the various World Congresses, European congresses, meetings of the management board, special human rights projects and activities, and contacts with national humanist member organizations. Only duplicates and received non-specific material have been removed. The archive now stretches 23,3 meters and includes 1109 folders. It is not known how many meters were involved before the several original parts were integrated into one.

Content

The archives contain documents on the following issues: The founding of the IHEU, its activities such as the world congresses, documents on board meetings of the General Assembly, the Executive Committee, the board of Directors and other boards. Information on various projects. Furthermore received and outgoing correspondence with countries, international governmental and non-governmental organisations, member organisations, and individual members and also documents on specific subjects such as organisation, finances, office affairs and membership and affiliation. Finally, the

personal archives from R. A. P. Tielman and J. W. F. Klein-von Baumhauer on the IHEU have been deposited. The archive covers the period from 1947 to 2006.

Language

Most documents are in English. Only if an other language has been used, it is mentioned.

Accessibillity

The entire archive is fully open to the public.
